8:30 am Ski & Snowboard School Opens.

On weekends and during holiday periods we are open from 8:00am. We strongly advise that you aim to arrive, at the parking lot, at this time to allow for sufficient time to register and prepare for the lesson.

Parents will be responsible for taking their kids through the registration and rental process and dropping them off at the Archway.

9:15 am Registration Closes

Your child must be registered before 9:15am in order for them to participate in the Full Day or Morning lessons.

Registration for Afternoon lessons is until 12:15pm. Based on availability.

9:45 am Drop Off and Class Formation

Drop off for Full Day and Morning Lessons is at the Wooden Arch. Classes will begin forming at 9:45am, the earlier you are, the more time we have to help your child find the right class.

10:00 am Lessons Begin

12:00 pm Pick Up for Morning Lessons Only If your child is enrolled in a morning lesson, pick-up is at the Wooden Arch.

12:00 - 1:00 pm Lunch Time

Children enrolled in the Full Day program will eat lunch at Thunder Gulch. Upper level lessons may eat lunch at the top of the mountain.

12:45 pm Afternoon Lesson Drop Off

Drop off is at the Wooden Arch. Classes will begin forming at 12:45pm for a 1:00pm start.

3:30 pm Pick Up Time

Children in Full Day and Afternoon lessons are available for pick up in the Corral.

End Of The Day:

If you have a reservation for tomorrow, check in at the rental tent to inquire about keeping your equipment.

If you don't have a reservation for tomorrow, the rental equipment must be returned to the Wild Mountain rental tent before 4:30pm.

Parent Contact
