Ages 5 – 6 Lesson Itinerary

8:30 am Ski & Snowboard School Opens.
On weekends and during holiday periods we are open from 8:00am. We strongly advise that you aim to arrive, at the parking lot, at this time to allow for sufficient time to register and prepare for the lesson.

Parents will be responsible for taking their kids through the registration process. Drop off is right after registration and up to 9:15am. Ski & Snowboard School employees will be responsible for your child from then on until the end of the day.

9:15 am Registration Closes
Your child must be registered and dropped off before 9:15am in order for them to participate in the Full Day or Morning lessons.

9:15 am – 10:00 am Lesson Preparation
During this period all children are fitted with equipment, sorted into classes and partake in indoor activities such as arts & crafts, games and coloring. This helps them get comfortable in their new environment and to introduce the sport in a fun and exciting way.

10:00 am Lessons Begin
This includes a combination of indoor and on snow ski/snowboard related activities continuing their adventure by introducing the physical aspects of the sport.

Children with prior on snow experience are assessed and higher level classes will head out to explore the mountain.

Throughout the morning, snacks and adequate break time is included to keep kids interested and energized.

12:00 pm Pick Up for Morning Lessons Only
If your child is enrolled in a morning lesson, pick-up is at the Wooden Arch.

12:00 – 1:00 pm Lunch Time

12:15 pm Afternoon Lesson Drop Off
Drop off is at the Wild Mountain Registration Area. Lesson begins at 1:00pm.

3:30 pm Pick Up Time
Children in Full Day and Afternoon lessons are ready for pick up in the Corral. Your child's instructor will be available should you have any questions.

4:00 pm Wild Mountain Closes (4:30pm weekends and holidays) Check availability for the following day and make a reservation.

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Ages 5 – 6 Important Information

Parents... Remember that a good night's sleep, a hearty breakfast and plenty of fluids will help keep your child energized and active.

Children must be toilet trained and socially and emotionally ready for Ski & Snowboard School.

Parent Contact

In case we need to contact you, the Ski & Snowboard School will use the contact numbers you provided during registration. Cell Phones have limited coverage at our resort; please check your messages throughout the day. Please also periodically check the message boards located at the base of the lifts and in the base area. If your child's name appears here contact us as soon as possible. For the safety of your child, parents **MUST** remain on the premises.

Allergies or Medication

Please be sure to inform us if your child has any food allergies or dietary requirements. Allergic children are welcome to bring their own lunch to be stored by the staff. The Wild Mountain staff is not authorized to administer medication to children.

Pick Up

For your child's safety, when picking up your child, you **MUST** have the pickup slip that was given to you at the beginning of the day. If you misplace the slip, please contact the Ski & Snowboard School prior to the scheduled pickup time.

Report Cards

At the end of the lesson your child will receive a report card detailing what they learned and what level they should enter into should you choose to return. Bring your report card next time to help us learn a little more about you and your skiing/riding!

Clothing Required – PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING

Children should arrive, dressed in layers, ready to ski or board. This includes: waterproof pants and jacket, warm socks, waterproof mittens, goggles/sunglasses, sun block.

Retail items are available at the Wild Mountain Ski & Snowboard School.

Helmets and ski pants are available for rental.
